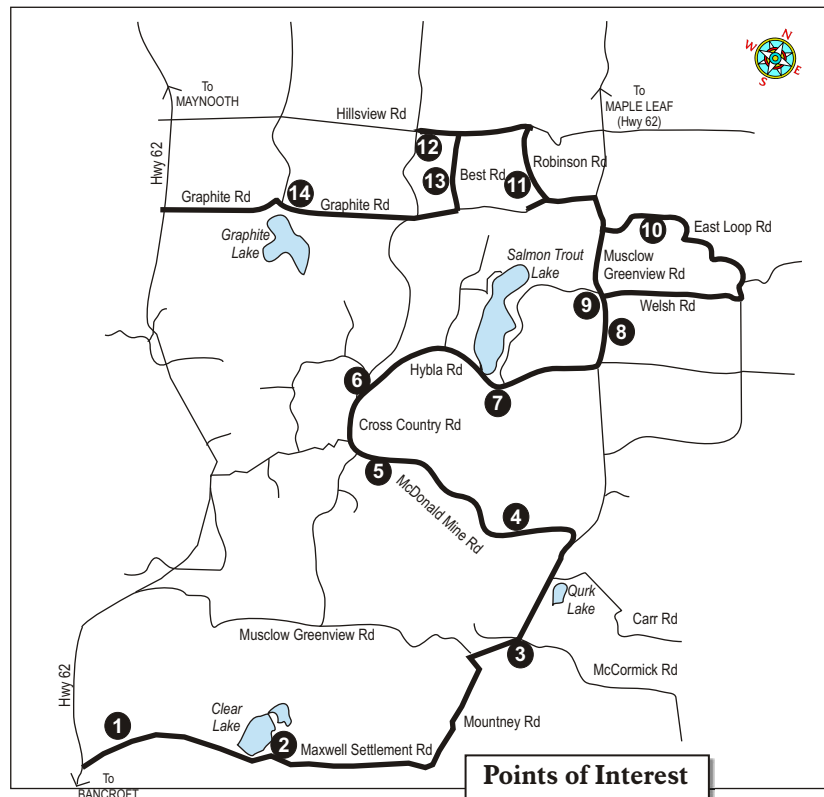

- 1 Maxwell Settlement - named for James Maxwell, one of the first homesteaders to farm free land grant in the area - had 15 children.
- 2 Pioneer home of Lawrence O'Marra, first postmaster in area.
- 3 Bethel United Church - original tin siding.
Musclow Hall - originally an old school house.
- 4 Universal Seal - manufactures machinery seals for export all over the world - employs about 25.
- 5 MacDonald Mine - has rare radioactive elements as well as feldspar crystals several feet across - operated from 1919 - 1935.
- 6 Hybla Zion Church - est. 1886 - originally Methodist.
- 7 Outlet creek of Salmon Trout Lake - pioneer site of Bartlett Mill and Cheese factory.
- 8 Draumer (Dreamer) Farm - Icelandic horse farm.
- 9 Former Monteagle Twp office.
- 10 Spectacular view of Monteagle Valley.
- 11 Robinson Rd - Kelly's Pick-Your-Own Fruit Farm.
- 12 Highest point of view from McAlpine's Farm - patented 1863.
- 13 Another Kodak moment from Annelee Acres - owned by Joe Best, former Reeve of Monteagle Twp.
- 14 Graphite Bible Camp.
